New outdoor area enhances Hobart Airport

A new and enhanced entrance way to Hobart Airport has been unveiled to offer more public facilities in anticipation of the redevelopment of the terminal facility.

The new Hobart Airport forecourt provides additional outdoor seating as well as an entrance way to the airport and will see a popup coffee shop, the Crate Cafe, providing toasties, pastries and other snacks.

Hobart Airport CEO, Norris Carter said it was great to be able to remove some of the hoarding at the entrance way to the airport and reveal the new outdoor facilities.

Construction of the new forecourt began in June, by Moore Civil, who employed a team of 35 tradespersons to lay over 1,000m² of decorative surfaces and create the space.

“We are delighted to reveal this new area, as we get things ready for the expansion of the terminal and to build a new runway,” Mr Carter said.

Mr Carter said the new area will give the travelling public further options when using the airport and make the entrance area a more pleasant place to be.

“While it is only a small part of what we plan to do, it is an important step towards the greater redevelopment of the site.”

Mr Carter said the airport had wherever possible used Tasmanian products such as local aggregate, sandstone pavers and plantings.

Moore Civil Director, Luke Moore said it was great to work on the new forecourt, creating jobs for Tasmanians and enhancing the experience for interstate and overseas travellers.

Hobart Airport Forecourt redevelopment partnerships included Project management by Planned Performance, building contractor - Moore Civil Contracting, forecourt architect – Playstreet, landscape contractors – Landscape Solutions Tasmania, ongoing grounds maintenance – J & J Cate Ground Maintenance, electrical contractor – Blackout Contractors and concrete contractor – Precision Concreting Tasmania.
